As long as the costume order has not been placed, you will receive a full refund if you decide to not participate in the show. We make every effort to keep costume prices low and for combination classes, we try to use a 2-in-1 costume. The final cost of the costumes will be given to you by mid-November and a copy of the costume will be left in the office in the COSTUME BOOK for you to see. Teachers will be measuring students and consulting parents on the correct size to order in November.
